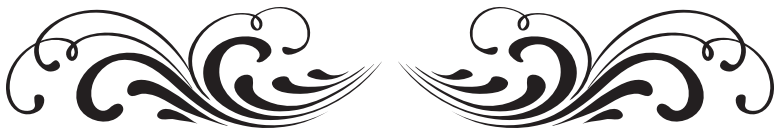

John Harwood, CNBC Chief Washington Correspondent and political writer for *The New York Times*, began his accomplished career in journalism with the *Washington Star* while still in high school. After graduating magna cum laude from Duke University, he went on to report on local government and politics for the

St. Petersburg Times and served as a state capital correspondent in Tallahassee, Washington correspondent and Political Editor. Harwood was named a Neiman Fellow at Harvard University in 1989, and then joined *The Wall Street Journal* as White House correspondent, covering the George H.W. Bush administration and reporting on Congress before becoming the *Journal's* Political Editor and chief political correspondent.

Today, Harwood writes for *The New York Times*, and has served as CNBC's Chief Washington Correspondent since 2006. He also offers political analysis on NBC's "Meet the Press" and PBS's "Washington Week in Review," among other television and radio programs. Harwood has covered each of the last five presidential elections.
